

The decision of the Medical Council in the case of Maryam al-Shamiri

By virtue of Law 28 of 2000, establishing the Medical Council,

By virtue of Law (26) 2002, on the performance of the medical and pharmaceutical profession,

By virtue of the decision of the president of the Supreme Political Council 22 of 2019, establishing the Medical Council,

By virtue of the minutes of the Medical Council meeting 5.3 of 2019,

By virtue of the technical report from the committee dealing with emergencies, urgent cases and supervision of professional medical performance of 22-6-1444 Hijra/16/1/2023 CE and the minutes of council meeting (28) of 1444 hijra, which adopted the recommendations of the committee over the complaint made by Riyadh Ali Abdul Raqib al-Shamiri (brother of the patient) against the Dr Ezzaldeen Al-Shaibani Hospital, Capital District, dated 5-5-1444 Hijra/3/12/2023 CE.

Ruling:

Item 1 – contents of the technical report of the committee:

Technical failing in that the person who administered anaesthesia was unqualified; responsibility lies with the hospital administration and the person who administered the anaesthetic.

Faulty procedure of transferring of the patient from the operating theatres to the intensive care unit before her condition had been fully stabilised.

The haemorrhage that occurred during the caesarean section is deemed to have been a complication of this type of surgery.

Item 2 - a copy of the technical report and the ruling of the council shall be submitted to the specialist in follow up and implementation in the General Secretariat in order to:

- Attach a copy of the technical report and the ruling of the council to the Minister of Public Health and Population.
- Attach a copy of the technical report and the ruling to the Public Prosecutor.
- Attach a copy of the technical report and the ruling of the council to the General Manager of the Health Office, Capital District.

Item 3 – This ruling shall be effective from the date it is issued.
