"When the police intervene, they take whatever measures are needed to calm both sides during the clash and end the problem. Because the two sides are engaged in fighting with each other, the police arrest people from both sides until the crisis is brought under control.

If the clash escalates into a killing, police personnel take the women and detain them by force; if no killing occurs, they do not arrest the women even if the accused is not present. No charges are brought against the women during their detention; they are simply held until the dispute is contained and the problem is resolved."
