Call with the Cham Wings Airlines employee in Beirut

Employee: The cost is 1150 USD which includes your ticket and security clearance.

Reporter: Will I depart from Beirut or Damascus?

Employee: From Beirut. From Damascus, it will cost 1200 USD.

Reporter: Ok. So I can travel from Damascus. But how will I get to Beirut? **Employee**: You take a car into Beirut. But you have to get there from the

"source" itself.

Reporter: The "source"? I am not sure I understand.

Employee: The source is Damascus. You have to arrive here from Damascus. **Reporter**: Ok, I understand. So the security clearance is included in the ticket price?

Employee: Yes, it is included in the 1150 USD.

(Employee is briefly sidetracked by another conversation) **Reporter**: Ok, are there any other fees for me to pay?

Employee: No. All you need to do is get yourself here in Beirut.

Reporter: Is the flight guaranteed?

Employee: Yes Sir, the trip is 100% guaranteed. Don't worry about a thing. You have a 2-hour transit in Egypt and then you continue your trip. Someone will receive you at Bengazi Airport.

Reporter: Ok. How do I make the necessary payment?

Employee: You make the payment after your initial reservation. Someone you know can hold the amount for you here in Beirut.

Reporter: Ok, let me see who I can send the money to, and I'll let you know. Regarding the person receiving us in Benghazi, is he a regular person or a representative?

Employee: He is a representative who will help you with all necessary arrival procedures, stamp your passport and take you out of the airport.
